Certificate II : Pre-Apprenticeship

Description and subject content: This course has no entrance criteria and is open and suitable for those seeking employment as an apprentice in Tile Laying. Applicants may, or may not be currently employed in the industry , may be sponsored by a potential employer, may be school leavers or mature aged .

Subjects covered include OH&S, planning, interpreting plans, measurement and calculation, demolition, preparation, use of tools, levelling, laying and repairing tiles and waterproofing. Students will also receive assistance to find employment for the 2 week practical session and on completion of the course.

Course Length: Full time for 16 weeks, 2 of which are spent on site with qualified employers.

Qualification: Upon successful completion of this course, students will receive the Certificate II in General Construction (Wall and Floor Tiling)

Certificate III: Apprenticeship

Description and subject content: This course provides comprehensive training for Tilelaying apprentices in all practical and theoretical aspects of the trade. Provided Holmesglen has vacancies, entry into the course is automatic for all employed apprentices.

Modules to be completed include and expand on those subjects in the pre-apprenticeship course with specific requirements on practical work to be met. Assessment is based on competency as evidenced by observation, discussion, written assignments, examinations and practical/ work related projects.

Course Length: Tilelaying apprenticeships are for a period of 4 years. Apprentices attend for 8x1 week blocks each year for 3 years, a total of 944 hours. Apprentices who have completed the Certificate II prior to this will have the length of their apprenticeship reduced.

Qualification: Upon successful completion of their apprenticeships, students will receive the Certificate III in General Construction (Wall and Floor Tiling)
