Who Can Apply

Those who have a Trade Qualification or minimum of 2 years waterproofing experience or OFT License in Construction Trade and a Construction Industry OH&S Induction Certificate.(Red Card)

Applicants must apply through AIW. As part of the assessment you will be required to complete the application form to provide evidence that proves you can do the work described in the competency standard.
