Certificate II: Pre-Apprenticeship

Description and course content: There are no formal entrance requirements. Applications from sponsored students are invited at any time. Places are also available for a limited number of unsponsored students. Every effort is made by teaching staff to find employment for unsponsored students.

Trainees work on full sized projects of varying degrees in NMIT's specially designed facilities. Training identifies and underpins the underlying requirements to collect, analyse and organise information, communicate ideas and information, plan and organise activities, work with others and in teams, use mathematical ideas and techniques, solve problems and use technology required within the industry.

Course length: Part time, 16x 40 hour weeks over 6 months.

Qualification: On successful completion the student will receive the Certificate II in General Construction(Wall and Floor Tiling)

Certificate III: Apprenticeship

Description and course content: Trainees are employed by wall and floor tilers and train on-site with their employer and off-site with NMIT. Applicants must be apprenticed.

Trainees work on full sized projects of varying degrees, in NMIT's specially designed facilities. Training identifies and underpins the underlying requirements to collect, analyse and organise information, communicate ideas and information, plan and organise activities, work with others and in teams, use mathematical ideas and techniques, solve problems and use technology required within the industry.

Course length: Schooling is part time consisting of 8x40 hour (1 week) blocks per year over 3 years.

Qualification: Upon successful completion of this course the trainee will receive the Certificate III in General Construction (Wall and Floor Tiling)
